

APRIL 2008 NEWSLETTER

We began the month of March by officially establishing our first church plant on the camp property. We had a full day of celebration! The National Overseer, Bro. Nunez formed the church with 16 members and Dan was named the Pastor. Six were new members, including our son Kyle. The other 9 were members whose membership were transferred because they now live on the camp property or near by.

A young couple who joined as new members also got married and then were baptized along with 2 others. This young couple has a beautiful baby girl and felt the Lord telling them that they should get married but they didn't have the money to do so. Dan presented their desire to the rest of our church here and the money started to come in. Not just money but the other necessities also. The groom was loaned a suit. The bride was loaned a beautiful wedding dress and shoes that looked like they were made just for her. We even had decorations brought by some of the ladies. There was such a feeling of unity and excitement to be able to do this for them. The church committed by faith to provide the wedding meal after the service. We all felt this was a tremendous ministry opportunity to bless them and to have neighbors come to the wedding and our church celebration. We normally have around 40 for service including the 20 children from the children's home. We planned on 100 with all the wedding guests plus the regular church people. We had 120 people stay for dinner and somehow had enough food for everyone.

We were also privileged to have a group of 9 from Canada including our Pastor come to visit. It was wonderful to catch up on our friends and make a few more from Canada. They showered the children in the children's home with gifts and love. The group enlarged our children's home, the Pastor taught at a men's retreat, they did door to door evangelism, magic tricks with a gospel message and showed the Jesus film in 3 different areas.

One of the showings for The Jesus Film for Children was at the camp property during Easter vacation. Dan went to the children's school to ask permission to hand out invitations to all the children. The teacher told Dan that it was too far for some of the students to walk to so could we also show it at the school. Wow! We had over 100 children and adults come to the camp for the movie. Gustavo and Saul showed it at the school after the group left, to the 80 kids plus teachers.

On Easter Sunday a man came to the camp telling us that some of his family wanted to come to service but they needed a ride. Dan and Daniel took vehicles and went to pick them up. After service Dan sat down with them and they told him that they wanted to start services in the home of one of the ladies if he would come. Dan went that Wednesday night to do the first service. They live in the other direction from the camp where Dan has wanted to start doing evangelism. Ephesians 3:20 talks about God doing above and beyond all that we ask or think, this certainly is what has been happening here.

It has been a very exciting month and we especially want to thank each of you for your prayer support. This month has been a month where we have felt the results of your prayers over and over again. God bless all of you.
